## **Minutes of the County Committee Meeting Held at Frenchfields, Penrith 10th July 2010 @ 4pm**

### **Minutes of the last meeting – accuracy and approval**

#### **Tournament Organiser's Report – Chris Battersby**

Frostbite

Chris reported that the Frostbite went well, there were low numbers of archers competing this year, but it still made a profit.

County Outdoor FITA

Chris commented that it was disappointing that there were so few archers from Cumbria, but there were good numbers of archers from outside the county. It was suggested that future County shoots should be promoted more within the county clubs. There was a suggestion that there should also be a "Field Party" to help move targets etc. Volunteers for the field party would receive some payment-in-kind (beer).

#### County FITA Clout

Chris reported a 33% increase in archers entering this shoot. The rent for the field has increased from £100 to £120. Frenchfields are a good venue, as it is easy to get to, from outside the county. There is no intention to charge for camping. Frenchfields are booked for next year's shoot.

There was no report from the NCAS meeting, as Chris did not attend. Malcolm Hedley did attend, but was not present at this committee meeting.
