



Cumbria County Archery Association **Junior and Senior** **Ranking 2010**

GNAS operates a ranking system for Junior Archers, which is open to anyone to put their scores forward for. At present, it operates over the outdoor season, and covers all age groups, and the three main bow-types, Compound, Longbow, and Recurve. It is proposed that Cumbria operate a similar system for both junior and senior archers

To be included, you should submit your three best scores using the Ranking Form shown below

- Rankings are worked out each year, scores to be achieved between 1st January and 31st December inclusive.
- Three scores to be submitted, which have to have been shot at open competitions.
- The rounds used should be over 12 dozen arrows. You may shoot any 12-dozen round appropriate to your gender and GNAS age group or older at the time of shooting.
- Data from county, regional and National shoots will be automatically included in the ranking data, however if you wish to ensure scores from competitions outside of county are used, you must send the form with your best scores to the organiser.
- The final ranking list is worked out using the GNAS Handicap tables. The handicap ratings of the three scores are added together, and the archer with the lowest total comes first. This means that, when you are deciding which scores to put in, you should choose the three that have the lowest handicap ratings. If in doubt, check with your club Records Officer. If fewer than three scores are submitted, the missing scores will be given a handicap equivalent of 100.
- When the list is published, it contains all scores in sixteen separate lists (Compound, Longbow Barebow and Recurve for Senior Gentlemen, Senior Ladies, Junior Gentlemen and Junior Ladies). It also shows the GNAS age groups for juniors. So, you can see your overall and age group ranking.
- Submissions for ranking must be made on the appropriate form. Electronic submission will be permitted.

- The deadline for submissions is 8th January. Forms received later than that date might not be included.
- The organiser is not responsible for data omissions where archers have not submitted their scores.
- A preliminary ranking list will be sent to all clubs within one week of the deadline and clubs will have two weeks in order to allow archers to check the data and provide feedback to the organiser if necessary. Final rankings will be published on the 31st January 2011. No updates will be made after this date.
